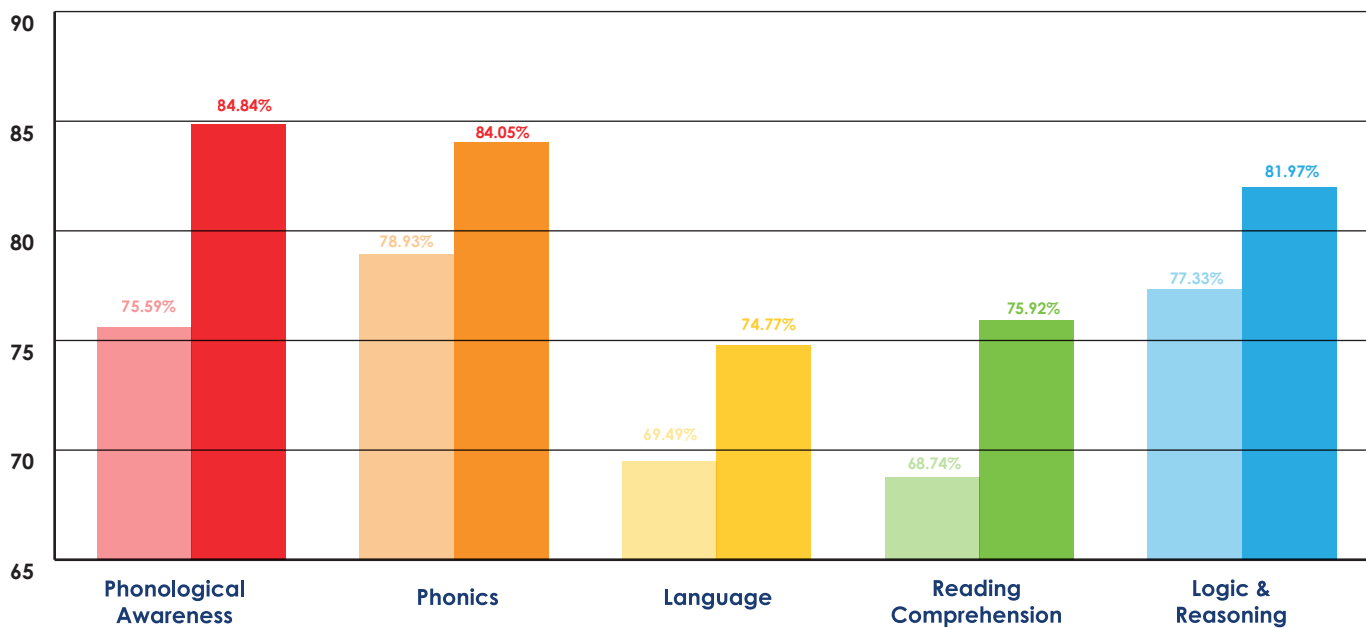


RESULTS OF PSJA EARLY LITERACY INITIATIVE

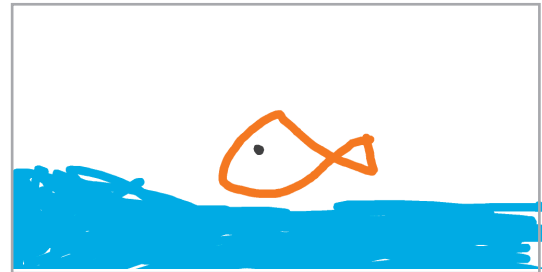
Emergent Bilingual Student Writing

Responding to prompt: "I am afraid"



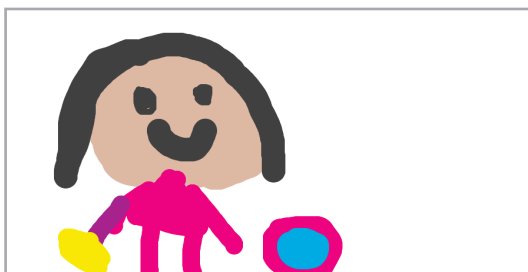
Responding to prompt: "My favorite animal"

Responding to prompt: "My favorite song"



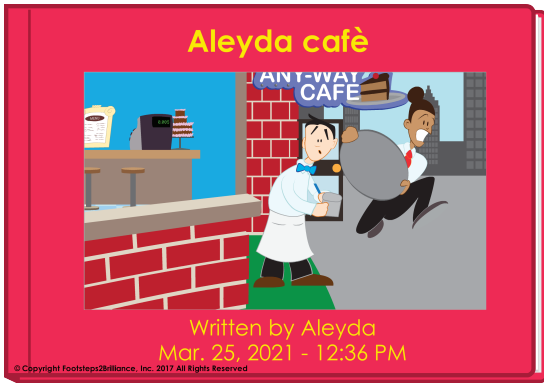
